BEHAVIOUR CONTRACT FOR SCHOOL VISITS



The rules of the trip are outlined below. You must sign that you agree to abide by them.

- You are not allowed to take, buy or consume alcohol or any other banned substances.
- You are not allowed to chew gum in the hostel.
- You must not take or purchase knives, laser pens, firecrackers, flick combs or similar items.
- You must show respect to the teachers and staff at the hostel.
- You must show respect to each other.
- Boys are not allowed in girls' rooms.
- Girls are not allowed in boys' rooms.
- You must listen to instructions and follow them at all times.
- You must be punctual when returning to meeting points.
- You must be generally quiet in rooms and silent after "lights out".
- You must be reasonably quiet in the public areas of the hostel.
- You must not wander off on your own.
- You must not take goods from shops without paying for them.
- You must pay special attention to the traffic when near roads.
- You must keep your passport, travel permit and emergency details with you at all times.
- **You must not take or share photographs, eg. on social networking sites or mobile phones, which you would not like others to take of you.**
- **You are not allowed to take any photos in the bedrooms / bathrooms.**
- **There is to be no inappropriate use of social network sites like Facebook in connection with this trip.**

Most pupils are a credit to their parents and the school when on school visits. Pupils who break this contract may be punished, either on the trip or back at school and may not be considered for future school visits.

This contract should be signed by the pupil and the parent(s).
The slip should be returned to school by the Friday before the visit.
