GO 4 Schools – Parental Access to Attendance, Behaviour and Assessment Data

For the past few months The Becket School has been using a new online system for tracking students' attendance, behaviour and assessment data. We are now excited to be in the position to offer parents access to that online system which will allow us to work together in even greater partnership.

By logging into this system you will be able to have immediate information about how your child is doing at school. You will be able to see:

- Their timetable
- Their attendance
- Their positive and negative behaviour points
- Information about their target grades and assessment grades
- Reports

There is also a facility so that you are emailed a summary at the end of each week.

In the long term, the school is likely to upload reports to this online system and that will be the primary way you will be able to access their reports.

The school will not be going 'live' with data for Year 11 until 30th January 2018 and we will provide instructions on how to do this at the Year 11 Parents' Consultation Evening. A member of staff will also be available on the evening to show parents how to access the information.
