In Memory of Alphin Abraham

As you may be aware, over the Easter break one of our Sixth Form students, Alphin Abraham, very sadly passed away. Alphin was a very positive and inspiring person who was actively involved in the Becket community. This is a very difficult time for many of us as she will be greatly missed.

Alphin was an extremely selfless person and was inspired by the work of a charity that she encountered on a Netflix documentary called "Daughters of Destiny". The charity, "Shanti Bhavan Children's Project", provides education for some of India's poorest children, who would otherwise not have access to education. It gives them the opportunity to achieve academic success in the hope that they will be able to lift their families and communities from poverty. Alphin wished to support this charity and a memorial fund has been set up in her name to raise money for their work.
