Dear Parent / Carer,

I hope you are all keeping safe and well and thank you once again for all the support you are giving to our staff as we all try to work together.

We are now at the stage of making plans for the next stage of support for our students. This will involve introducing some face to face support for our Year 10 and 12 students in school and continuing the support we give to our vulnerable children and to the children of key workers.

The plan is to do things gradually and give you as much notice as possible to enable you to plan ahead. Of course all of this is dependent on the government plan to bring the country out of our current lockdown situation meeting its key criteria.

**Week Commencing 1<sup>st</sup> June** – Children of key workers and children who are vulnerable will continue to be supervised and supported in school.

**Week Commencing the 8<sup>th</sup> June** – Children of key workers and children who are vulnerable will continue to be supported in school and Year 10 students will return on a part-time basis for some face to face sessions in school .

**Week Commencing the 15<sup>th</sup> June** – Children of key workers and children who are vulnerable will continue to be supported in school. Year 10 will continue their second week of face to face sessions in school and Year 12 will also start some face to face sessions in school.

Throughout these three weeks Years 7, 8 and 9 should continue with their remote learning.

I will be sending out more information on proposed start dates, timings, safety measures etc. when we are ready to do so, but please be aware that this is dependent on further government decisions about the lockdown and also the availability of staff to provide the face to face support.

I hope you find this initial information useful and I know that you will have a number of questions, but would ask that you wait until the full information comes out before sending these to the school.

Please also be aware that staff are working incredibly hard in very challenging and unique circumstances and we are doing all we can to support our families and our young people.
